Night Warehouse Associate Series:

The Night Warehouse Associate 1 is the first in a series of 6 levels that an employee can grow through in the Night Warehouse Associate title. Employees in this series must select product at least 75% of the time they are working. Employees will receive greater compensation as they progress through the series. Progression is based on reaching and maintaining minimum productivity and accuracy levels during a measurement period. The minimum standards expected of the Night Warehouse Associate 1 are listed below;

• Cases per Hour: 110

• Accuracy Rate: 1 error permitted for every 4,000 cases selected

Job Overview:

A Night Warehouse Associate, under the direction of the Warehouse Supervisor, is responsible for picking orders from the dry, cooler, and freezer sections of the warehouse. A Night Warehouse Associate uses an automated pick system to assist them with picking orders and must consistently check their picked orders for accuracy. A Night Warehouse Associate is also responsible for replenishing product in the appropriate pick slots along with preparing and loading pallets on trailers. A Night Warehouse Associate must adhere to warehouse safety and food safety regulations at all times. A Night Warehouse Associate will also complete general warehouse and housekeeping tasks as necessary or required.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Uses an automated pick system to pick orders from the dry, cooler, and freezer sections of the warehouse.
- 2. Replenishes product in the appropriate pick slots.
- 3. Builds and wraps pallets in a manner that allows for safe transport of the product.
- 4. Loads pallets of product onto trucks using warehouse rolling stock.
- 5. Accurately handles product to maintain warehouse management system data integrity.
- 6. Safely handles product in compliance with documented Food Safety/HACCP standard operating procedures.
- 7. Complies with company safety rules at all times.
- 8. Minimizes product damage and waste to maximize product quality control.
- 9. Maintains a safe, organized and clean workplace throughout every scheduled shift.
- 10. Practices a "Clean As You Go" approach to their work by working cleanly to maintain an inspection-ready facility at all times.
- 11. Sorts pallets, bins, trash, cardboard and plastic into appropriate locations.
- 12. Follows directions set by Warehouse Supervisor.

Additional Responsibilities:

- 1. Cross-trained to support all functions of the position.
- 2. Other duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- 1. Ability to use sound judgment and maturity when dealing with unexpected issues.
- 2. Ability to perform multiple tasks in a fast-paced, team-driven work environment
- 3. Ability to follow written and verbal instructions.
- 4. Ability to understand documented best practices and operate according to the same.
- 5. Ability to perform all job functions in various temperatures, including subzero temperatures.
- 6. Ability to attain established productivity standards for each function.
- 7. Ability to observe all safety, product handling and security guidelines and participate in the daily stretching program.
- 8. Ability to lift/move 80 pounds of product.
- 9. Ability to satisfactorily complete ongoing training requirements.
- 10. Basic computer knowledge highly desirable.
- 11. Possesses a customer service, team-oriented attitude.
- 12. Good organizational abilities, follow-up skills, and attention to details both in their work and when communicating with the team.
- 13. Strong English language aptitude, including the ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- 14. Ability to multi-task.
- 15. Punctual and dependable.
- 16. Courteous and tactful.
